Agenda No. 12: Appointment of Adjunct Professor, Visiting Professor and Emeritus Professor.

Details

[I]. Guidelines proposed for appointment of Adjunct Professor, Visiting Professor and Emeritus Professor in BASU, Patna:-

Adjunct Professor (As per UGC guidelines):-

- 1. In order to establish useful and viable collaboration with other Universities and to attract distinguished Individuals who have excelled in the field of their specialization, the Scheme of Adjunct Professor is proposed to be introduced at Bihar Animal Sciences University, Patna.
- 2. Adjunct Faculty is proposed to be appointed by the Competent authority based on recommendation of a Committee. Period of empanelment may vary from six months to three years as decided by the University on mutually agreed terms & conditions.
- 3. The strength of such Adjunct Faculty may not exceed twenty five percent of the sanctioned faculty strength.
- 4. The Adjunct Faculty will be provided travel cost as per entitlement from his/ her Institution of posting and back, maximum six times per Academic Year. No reimbursement for hiring accommodation will be permissible. However, he/ she will be provided free boarding and lodging in the University Guest House.
- 5. He/ She will be provided honorarium of Rs. 1,000/- per lecture to a maximum of Rs. 4,000/- per day subject to a maximum ceiling of Rs. 80,000/- per month.
- 6. The Adjunct Faculty must work at the host Institution for a minimum of two days per visit.
- 7. A person from the parent University should not be appointed as a Adjunct Professor in the same University.

Emeritus Professor (As per ICAR guidelines):-

- A Professor of repute in any field of Veterinary & Animal Sciences who has superannuated from recognized University/ICAR institutes in India and abroad.
- 2. He/ She can be appointed for a maximum period of three years upto the age of 68 years.
- 3. Will be paid a remuneration of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty thousand) per month as per the guidelines of ICAR with an Annual Contingency of Rs. 50,000/- (non-lapsable per year) to meet the expenditure of stationery and TA allowances.
- 8. At the end of assignment, every Adjunct Faculty will submit a "Performance Report" to the host University or College that may be considered for his continuation/renewal of his/her next tenure.
- A Professor should not be appointed as a Emeritus Professor in the same University in which he/ she holds a post immediately before or after superannuation.

Visiting Professor (As per UGC guidelines):-

- 1. A person who has held or is holding the post of Professor.
- 2. Maximum tenure of appointment is two years and the minimum not less than three months.
- 3. The University may appoint a person upto the age of 70 years.
- 4. A Professor should not be appointed as a visiting Professor in the same University in which he/ she holds a post immediately before or after superannuation.
- 5. Superannuated person is appointed as a visiting Professor, the honorarium payable should not exceed Rs, 15,000/- per month excluding superannuation benefits.
- 6. If a person is appointed as visiting Professor from outside the Country, his/her honorarium will be Rs. 20,000/- per month.
- 7. The visiting Professor will be provided free accommodation in University Guest House but he/she will have to pay the food charges.

[II]. Appointment of Adjunct Professor, Visiting Professor and Emeritus Professor will be done by a Committee constituted by competent authority.

The Academic Council approved the proposal for appointment of Adjunct Professor and Visiting Professor as per UGC guidelines and Emeritus Professor as per ICAR guidelines. Guidelines for selection and appointment of above positions will be detailed for approval of the Academic council.
