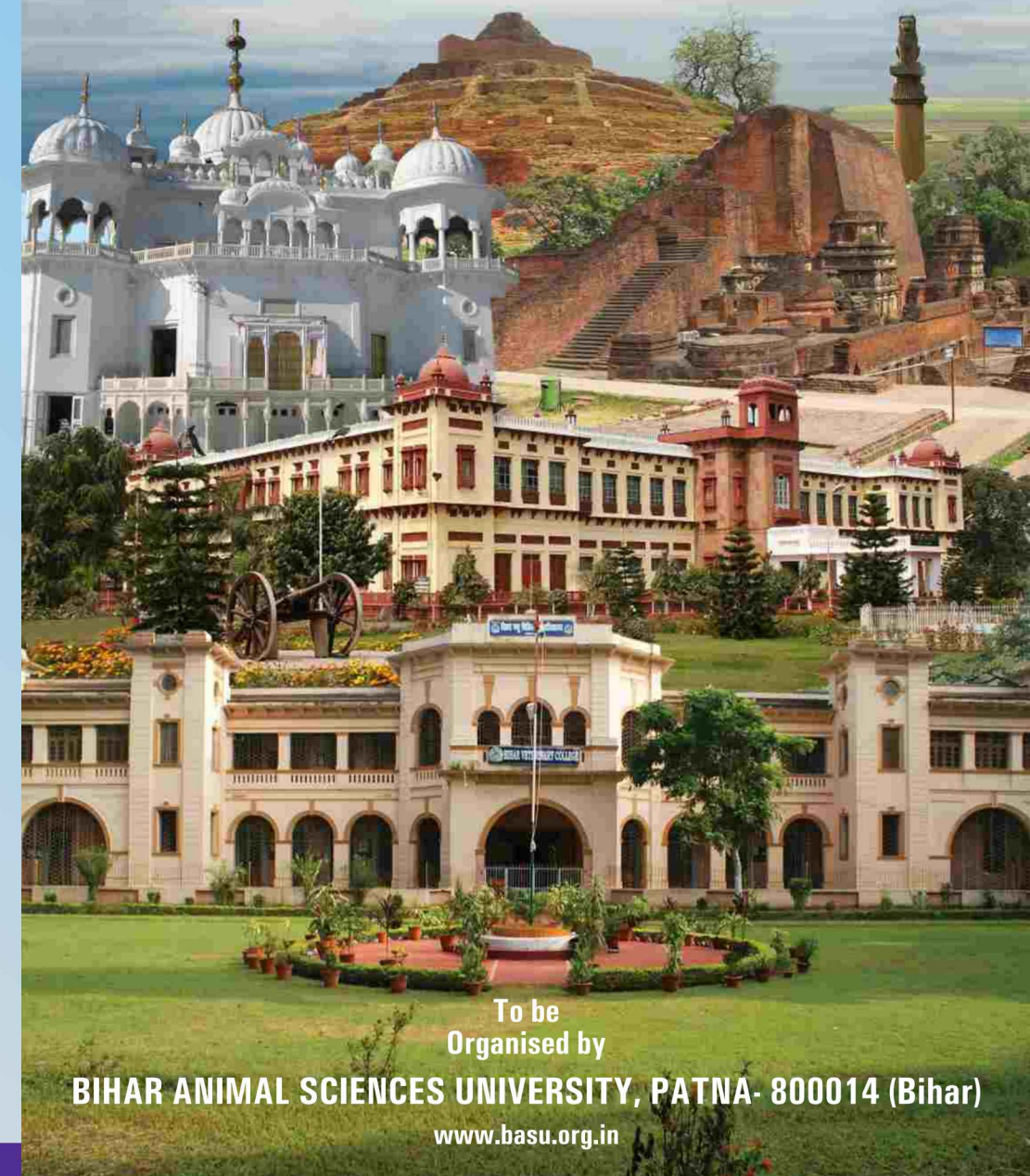

### Technical Sessions & Scientific Programme

Kulkarni Memorial Award, Dr C.M. Singh Best Research Paper Award, technical sessions on important topics, and round table/special session on selected topic by invitation. Each technical session comprises lead paper with oral and poster presentations. Apart from the theme session, following technical sessions will include:

### Submission of Abstracts

The abstracts of the original research work (not exceeding 350 words) for oral as well as poster presentations (size 60cm x 90cm) are invited for various sessions. All abstracts should be typed in Microsoft Word, Times New Roman, font size 12, double spaced. The abstract should contain title, name of the authors and place of work done with e-mail address of the presenting author. The text should comprise objective of the study, methodology applied, results and conclusion drawn in single paragraph. The abstracts should be submitted only by email to iavmiconf2018@gmail.com. **The abstract will be accepted only on receipt of registration fees of at least one of the authors.** The last date of submission of abstracts and invited papers is **15<sup>th</sup> January 2019**.
