ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

Bihar Animal Sciences University has been established through an act of Bihar State (BASU Act No. 15 of 2016, notified in the Bihar Gazette on 29 August 2016). The new University has been carved out of the Bihar Agricultural University with two of its constituent colleges, Bihar Veterinary College and Sanjay Gandhi Institute of Dairy Technology at Patna and a new College of Fisheries became operational at Kishanganj from academic session 2018-19. The university headquarters is located near Jai Prakash Narayan International Airport, Patna. The University has been established with primary aim to impart education in Veterinary Science, Animal Husbandry, Poultry, Fisheries, Dairy and other allied branches. Teaching is carried out through constituent colleges i.e. Bihar Veterinary College, Patna, Sanjay Gandhi Institute of Dairy Technology, Patna and College of Fisheries, Kishanganj, imparting undergraduate, post graduate and doctorate programmes. Directorate of Research is involved in monitoring research activities and securing external funding for research. Directorate of extension education is actively involved in transfer of technology through Krishi Vigyan Kendra and Pashu Vigyan Kendra, organization of Pashu melas & Health camps. Another important goal is to provide diagnostic, therapeutic services to livestock keepers of state through state of art diagnostic centers and Veterinary hospitals. Directorate of students welfare has brought vibrancy in students extracurricular sports activities and marked important in hostel management



CONSTITUENT UNITS OF THE UNIVERSITY

Bihar Veterinary College, Patna

The Bihar Veterinary College was established on 2nd April 1927 by Sir Henry Wheeler. Since, 2017, this college has produced more than 3000 graduates, post graduates and doctorates, who have brought laurels to the country and state. This is the only Veterinary college of state, which caters to the needs of trained manpower for teaching, research and extension education programs pertaining to livestock production and health problems.



The college is following Veterinary Council of India, minimum standard of Veterinary education (degree programme) through 18 departments. All these departments have experienced faculty and fully equipped laboratory facilities for teaching and research. The college is offering postgraduate programme in 16 disciplines and doctorate in 09 disciplines. A well-equipped Veterinary clinical complex and Instructional livestock farm are service windows of the college. Veterinary Clinical Complex is providing round the clock treatment with Indoor ward facility to cater to the demands of large & small animal as well as Pet health care. Extension wing of the college is not only involved in establishing linkages with livestock keepers of state, but also training the doctors in Animal management during emergency.



Sanjay Gandhi Institute of Dairy Technology, Patna

Sanjay Gandhi Institute of Dairy Technology is the only institute of its type in State having well developed residential campus and is engaged in teaching, research and extension activities in the area of Dairying Processing Dairy Technology, Dairy Engineering, Dairy Microbiology, Dairy Chemistry, Dairy Extension, Dairy Economics, Statistics & Computers. The Institute runs a four-year Bachelor Degree Program in Dairy Technology (B. Tech.DT). The institute has intake capacity of 25, at graduation level. which has been increased to 30 from current academic session. Large number of passing out graduates are getting campus placements. Institute is in process of setting up Modern dairy plant for on the campus, for teaching and training purpose.



College of Fisheries, Kishanganj

This is newly formed college which came into being from academic session 2018-19. It is located at Arrabri which is about 22 Km away from the district town of Kishanganj. College is situated on the banks of river Mahananda. Hon'ble Chief Minister of Bihar, Shri Nitish Kumar formally inaugurated first academic session of this college on 29th August, 2018. College campus is well developed and furnished academic block, farm lab., residential complex and hostel for Boys and Girls. Newly established college is of fisheries programme with intake capacity of 40 students. and plans to start post-graduation Programme.

Post Graduate Studies

The DRI-cum-Dean, Post Graduate Studies is responsible for overall regulation of resident instruction of the University, including admissions, enrolment of students in post graduate & doctorate programme. Academic reforms in form of attendance requirement, academic calendar has been implemented and the results is reflected, as three students were selected in ICAR- Junior Research Fellowship and two students got ICAR – Senior Research Fellowship.

Bihar Rural Livelihoods Promotion Society (JEEVIKA) and Cooperative Milk Federation (COMFED), made campus recruitment of passing out of passing out graduates of Bihar Veterinary College, Patna for first time. At present post graduate programme is being offered in 16 disciplines and doctorate in 09 disciplines of Bihar Veterinary College, 16 students are pursuing Ph.D. and 58 students are doing M.V. Sc. at Bihar Veterinary College, Patna. Master's programme at Sanjay Gandhi Institute of Dairy Technology and College of Fisheries is likely to be started soon.

Research

The Directorate of Research has been established with a mandate to visualize future research strategies and prioritize research in different disciplines of Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Poultry, Dairy Technology & Fisheries and to formulate and promote research to meet the farmers' needs through futuristic research. At present 10 externally funded and 09 institutional projects are in operation.

It envisaged to set up Modern Buffalo Breeding farm at Sipaya (Gopalganj) on 80 acres of farm area. Similarly at Tekna Farm, Gaya Model Goat Breeding farm with objective to meet the germ plasma supply in state and start production of Goat milk production unit along with Training and diagnostic center. Directorate of Research has facilitated Memorandum of understanding with leading National institutes and plans to form a regional research consortium comprising of medical and Veterinary research institutes of area to facilitate sharing of research facilities.



Extension Education

Directorate of Extension Education (DEE) has started functioning under Bihar Animal Sciences University, Patna since its inception. It has been supervising and controlling all extension activities of the university. It has been formulating the plan of action for Extension Education activities and training programme for execution through Extension wings and Krishi Vigyan Kendra.

University adopted two villages in Muzafarpur district as Poultry Gram Viz. Chakhelal and Mirzapur and distributed 1000 chicks and established a farmer's club. Directorate is regularly transferring the latest technology to the farmers on promotion of Backyard Poultry Farming and goat rearing. Beneficiary farmers are earning Rs. 600-700/- per bird on an average through sale of egg.

Organization of Animal Health camp in different parts of state is another flagship programme, in which specialist doctors provide on the spot treatment and advice along with monitoring of vaccination and deworming.

Student Welfare

The education policy of University embraces the concept of holistic development of the students and undertakes the activities that are essential in this regard. Various activities apropos development of soft skills and intrinsic qualities of the students are pursued emphatically to inculcate leadership qualities, human values, positive thinking and creativity among the students. Different sections have been created at college and university levels to facilitate, impart and monitor activities pertaining to Cultural and Literary activities, Sports and Games, National Cadet Core, National Social Service, Placement Cell etc. All these activities and sections are administered and monitored by the Director Student Welfare of the university. Alumni -cum-placement cell has been established in the University. Better coordination and management of has resulted in 53% increase in campus placements during 2018-19. For the first time Bihar Rural Livelihoods Promotion Society - JEEVIKA and COMFED made campus recruitment of passing out graduates of Bihar Veterinary College, Patna. Alumni cell too has been made functional and executive committee has been reconstituted and annual meet of the Alumni Association has been planned.
