B.V.Sc. & A.H. - 5½ years at Bihar Veterinary College, Patna

Basic eligibility criteria for B.V.Sc. & A.H. Degree Programme admission

- The candidate should have a minimum qualification of 10+2 or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry and Biology from a recognized Board/University.
- The candidate should have to qualify National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) with minimum qualifying percentile.
- National Testing Agency (NTA) will declare [NEET result 2020](#) in the month June-2020, and candidates who secure the category-wise minimum qualifying percentile will be eligible for admission in B.V.Sc. & A.H. Degree Programme, Bihar Veterinary College, Patna, Bihar.
- For counselling of **85% State Quota**, details of eligibility and other information may be seen in the prospectus issued by BCECE Board, Patna.
- For counselling of **15% All India Quota**, those candidates who clear NEET 2020 and get shortlisted under 15% AIQ, will have to register themselves for the process of counselling. The schedule for [NEET-2020 counselling](#) will be released by MCC on its official website. As per the directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the allotment of seats for NEET 15% AIQ seats will be done in two rounds only.

An enrolled student should complete the course credits prescribed from time to time and shall have to earn a minimum Overall Grade Point Average (OGPA) of 5.0 out of 10.0 in order to earn B.V.Sc. & A.H. Degree. After completion of course credits at the end of 4½ years, the student should satisfactorily complete an Internship Training Programme of one year duration.

Agreement Bond

When candidate is selected for admission, his/her parent/guardians will have to execute an Agreement Bond during admission to College in prescribed format, failure to execute the Agreement Bond will lead to cancellation of selection.

A student, who desires to leave the Degree Programme after closure of B.V.Sc. & A.H. admission of 2018-19 or on any date of subsequent years irrespective of the fact, should pay a sum of Rs. 3,00,000/- (Rupees three lakh only) by executing a bond as penalty.
