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1. Scope of Work and General Instructions to Bidders

Bihar Animal Sciences University intends to engage a reputed, well established and financially sound Manpower Supplying Agency, registered with appropriate authorities for supply of outsourced manpower to perform assigned jobs. The College of Fisheries, Kishanganj, BASU has tentative requirement of approximately 30 manpower in different cadres. Salary of outsourced staff will be as per Bihar state minimum wages act as mentioned in the *Annexure III*. However, the number of staff may increase / decrease based on College of Fisheries, Kishanganj requirements in different Units.

The post-wise scope of work is as under:

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2. General Instructions to Bidders

- i) The firm/contractor should provide the personnels as per qualifications and experience mentioned against each category of the posts for required works as determined by BASU for CoF, Kishanganj, BASU. The staff to be engaged will be selected through interview in the presence of Dean, CoF, Kishanganj, BASU. The firm has to submit copies of all the certificates/documenmts of each manpower to CoF, Kishanganj, BASU.
- ii). The staff deployed by the contractor/firm for the work is required to be regular in attending the office/task assigned and an alternative arrangement has to be made by the concerned agency whenever anyone of the staff is to go on leave/weekly rest under intimation to this office.
- iii). The staff provided should maintain discipline in the premises of CoF, Kishanganj, BASU and is required to be present on duty for 8 hours in the office/field as per requirement of CoF, Kishanganj, BASU, including half an hour lunch break during working days. The workmen may be called on duty even on Sundays and other gazetted holidays, if required. However, they will be entitled for other leave as per the applicable labour laws for manpower services.
- iv) If the contractual staff deployed by the contractor is not found on duty during the prescribed working hours, punitive action at the discretion of authority will be taken. The personnel to be deployed will be given paid weekly off as per provision of labour laws.
- v) The persons should be citizen of India and should not have attained the age of 55 years at the time of engagement. For retired government servants, the upper age limit will be 65 years at the time of engagement. However, age limit will be relaxable for especially suitable candidate at the discretion of the University.
- vi) Reservation in jobs will be as per Government of Bihar rules. Detailed job-wise reserved positions will be informed to the contractor with the supply order. The contractor will be responsible for supply of sufficient proportionate number or reserved category candidates as per demand of the University.
- vi) Necessity of the continuance of particular job may be reviewed after every 89 days or any timeframe decided by the University and if not found necessary, the job will be discontinued or replaced otherwise may be allowed to continue for next 89 days or any period as decided by the University with 01 day compulsory break in engagement. However, one can be replaced any time by the CoF, Kishanganj, BASU, Patna without any formal proceedings, without any prior notice and without assigning any reason.
- vii). Any kind of loss of the Govt. property due to negligence of the contractor's manpower, will be deducted from the contractor's bill of that or subsequent month.
- viii). During the contract period, CoF, Kishanganj, BASU will not be responsible for any miss-happening with the contractual manpower just like Snake bite, Skin disease or any accident/injury (including death) of the persons engaged and it will be full responsibility of the contractor for paying any compensation or any claim to the family of such persons during the contract period or later on awarded by any Court/Tribunal/Arbitrator etc.
- ix) The contractor will issue identity cards to his/her manpower.
- x) The contractor offered the contract will have to maintain an Attendance Register as per Format of CoF, Kishanganj, BASU and the same shall be made available to the concerned HOD/Incharge Sectional/Nodal Officer under whom the services will be provided. The contractor has to mark/close the absentee/presence statement every day on the Register based on which the concerned end user will verify the bill.
- xi). The agreement is terminable with one month notice at the discretion of CoF, Kishanganj, BASU.
- xii). The contractor shall not sublet the work without prior written permission of CoF, Kishanganj, BASU.
- xiii). The contractor or his workers shall not misuse the premises allotted to them for any purpose other than for which the contract is awarded.
- xiv). There will be no employer-employee relationship between CoF, Kishanganj, BASU and the persons so engaged by the contractor in the aforesaid service(s).
- xv) Payment for service contract will be made monthly upon submission of pre-receipted bills and after making payments to the concerned departments i.e. EPF/ESIC etc. through RTGS only.
- xvi). The bidder should quote the rate in the financial bid in respect of all services covered under this contract. No request for alteration in the service charge once quoted will be permitted during the contract period,
- xvi) The firm has to quote only the "Service Charges" per person per month in rupees and other liabilities, if any, to be levied by them for providing the services. TDS as applicable will also be deducted from the bill of the contractor at source. Though the rates of DA and other allowances & EPF/ESIC may be revised by Govt. from time to time, no change/revision whatsoever in service charges once quoted shall be admissible during the tenure of tender under any circumstances.
- xvii). The contractor will discharge all his legal obligations in respect of the workers/supervisors to be deployed by him for execution of the work. The contractor shall indemnify and CoF, Kishanganj, BASU will not be responsible for any claims, loss or damages that may be caused to it on account of any failure to comply with the obligations under various laws. In case of any dispute, the decision of the Competent Authority shall be final and binding on the Contractor.
- xix) Income Tax shall be deducted from the payments due for the work done as per rule and any other tax payable shall be paid by the contractor also.
- xviii). Changing of Contractual Staff should be intimated to the Dean, CoF, Kishanganj, BASU.
- xx). The contract is subject to the condition that the tenderer will comply with all the laws and acts of State Govt. relating to this contract made applicable from time to time.
- xxi). Payment of the wages to the persons deployed by the Agency/Contractor has to be made through RTGS only on or before 7th day of succeeding month to the account of worker and copy of payment sheet duly signed by

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authorized signatory of the Agency/Contractor should be made available to the Indenting Officer every month before verifying the monthly bill. However, in case, the payment to contractual workers is delayed, for whatsoever reason, beyond 07th day of the succeeding month, penalty @ Rs.1000/- per day will be imposed and deducted from the bill of the contractor. If the delay is repeated on more than three occasions, suitable punitive action, including debarment/blacklisting/termination of the contract will be initiated.

xxii). The Agency/Contractor shall display a copy of the license promptly at the work premises.

xxiii). a) Successful tenderer will have to enter into a detailed contract agreement with BASU on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs 1000/-. b) The successful bidder awarded the contract will have to submit a Performance Security equivalent @10% of the total annual value of the tender (initial value of the contract in the form of Bank Draft/TDR/FDR (pledged to BASU, Patna) which should be valid for a period of (12+2) = 14 months from the date of contract and which will be refunded to the contractor after successful completion of the contract and after discharging all the liabilities arises during the concurrency of the contract. In case, the contractor fails to discharge the liabilities of the contract or if the contractor fails to complete the contract successfully, the performance security as a whole or by a proportionate part will be realized from the performance security at the discretion of the CoF, Kishangani, BASU.

xxiv). The Competent Authority, BASU, Patna reserves the right to reject any or all Tenders in whole or in part without assigning any reason therefore. The decision of Competent Authority, BASU, Patna shall be final and binding on the Contractor/Agency in respect of clause covered under the contract.

xxy). The tenure of the Contract will be for a period of 12 months which may be extended, if required.

xxvi). Risk Clause: BASU reserves the right to discontinue the service at any time, if the services are found unsatisfactory by giving a show-cause to be replied within a week and also has the right to award the contract to any other agency at the risk and cost of current agency and excess expenditure incurred on account of this can be recovered from Performance Security or pending bills or by raising a separate claim.

xxvii). Submission of Bills along with ECR for EPF/ESIC payment to Contractual Workers, the firm awarded the Contract has to furnish ECR for EPF/ESIC for Contractual Workers separately every month to Dean, CoF, Kishanganj, BASU, without mixing the same with other organizations, failing which the bills will not be entertained.

4. Qualification Criteria for Bidder:

Followings are qualification criteria. Interested firm is required to enclose document/ certificate and affidavit (as applicable in this regard).

- 1. The bidder shall deposit an amount of Rs. 1,00,000.00/- (Rupees one lakh only) as Earnest Money in the shape of Bank Draft/Bankers Cheque from Nationalized or commercial Bank payable to Finance Comptroller, BASU, Patna.
- 2 The agency must have registration certificate under the Company's Act, 1956 or under other suitable provision for Job work for Manpower.
- 3. The agency must have Registration under Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970.
- 4. The agency must have ISO 9001:2015 certificate.
- 5. The agency must have certificate (with a list of clients) of experience of at least three years above in providing similar manpower to the reputed Govt. organizations / companies in India, 'In case micro and small enterprises will not meet out prior turnover and experience criteria, the same may be relaxed for micro and small enterprises by the competent Authority.
- 6. The Agency must have registration certificate under Bihar Shop & Establishment Act, 1953
- 7. Agency must have registration certificates of EPF, ESIC, GST and PAN under the relevant laws.
- 8. Agency should be registered under latest labour law of the state/Centre.
- 9. Agency must have an annual turnover of not less than 5 crores in each year in providing Manpower during the previous three Financial Years of 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20 supported by balance sheet and profit and loss account. In case micro and small enterprises will not meet out prior turnover and experience criteria, the same may be relaxed for micro and small enterprises by BASU Authority.
- 10. Agency must have minimum one thousand manpower on its pay-roll as per duly certified documents.
- 11. There should be no case pending with the police against the Company and should not have been blacklisted by any State/Central/PSU/Private organization etc. corroborated by a notarized affidavit to this effect.
- 12. Self-certificate should be provided that agency will follow the circular No 11/on 1-05/2017 GA 13876 dated 03.11.2017 of general administration department, Govt. of Bihar regarding reservation in manpower.
- 13. All pages of the bid document submitted must be duly signed and stamped by the firm as confirmation of acceptance of terms and conditions.
- 14. A consent that the firm agrees to open an office in the premises of College of Fisheries, Kishanganja, BASU for which they will be provided space free of cost.

5. Earnest Money Deposit:

The bidder shall deposit an amount of Rs. 1,00,000.00/- (Rupees one lakh only) as earnest money in the shape of Bank Draft/Bankers Cheque from Nationalized or commercial Bank payable to Finance Comptroller, BASU, Patna. EMD exemption is permitted to firms registered with MSME/NSIC. The Earnest money deposit will be refunded to bidders whose offers have not been accepted within 120 days of opening of tenders. Earnest Money Deposit of the bidder whose offer is accepted will be returned once the performance guarantee @ 10% of the monthly size of the contract or Rs. 1,00,000/- (whichever is higher) is furnished by the bidder.

6. Tender Procedure:

The interested agencies may participate in the online bidding process through e-procurement portal by submitting Technical and financial Bid. The firm has to submit hardcopy of Technical Bid with the required EMD to the Registrar, Bihar Animal Sciences University, Patna 800014

<u>Technical Bid</u>: Bidders must submit the photo-copies of the documents (originals to be submitted for verification when asked for) enumerated in qualification criteria along with demand draft of EMD. The technical bids, which are not accompanied with documents prescribed above and EMD are liable for rejection forthwith.

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<u>Financial Bid</u>: Financial bid should be online in the format enclosed with tender. The rate should be quoted on monthly basis in the prescribed format taking into account that the rates of wages should not be less than the minimum wages prescribed by the Bihar Govt. The price quoted shall be inclusive of all taxes.

- A) The bidders will be responsible to pay the wages as per minimum wages of Bihar State and all other obligations like EPF, ESI, Any other Statutory obligations, taxes, Administrative Charges if any, Overheads and Profits.
- B) BASU Patna will deduct TDS at the prescribed rate from the payment.
- C) Tender document with less than one percent service charge will not be acceptable.
- D) Bid shall be valid up to 225 days from date of submission of tender. Any variation in rates, price of term during the validity period of the offer shall require forfeiture of the EMD. Any other charges in whatsoever name other than specially except the variation in rate of taxes / duties and rete of minimum wages as per law shall not be allowed.
- E) Anyone or more of the following action / commission / omission are likely to cause rejection of bid summaly.
 - i. If not accompanied by required Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)/ proposal fee.
 - ii. If received unsealed or improperly sealed.
 - iii. Conditional bid shall not be entertained will be and out rightly be rejected.

F) The financial bid having less than one percent of service charges will be rejected.

7. Evaluation Criteria:

- i. Evaluation will be carried out on the basis of selection of lowest evaluated responsive bidder.
- ii. Firm meeting technical qualification criteria will be considered technically responsive.
- iii. Financial bid of the technically responsive bidders (only) will be opened.
- iv. The firm which has quoted the lowest prices in its financial bid will be considered for placing the order.
- v. In case if there are more than one L-1, then the successful bidder will be decided on draw of lottery among all such L-1's.
- vi. In case there is a single L1 bidder and the firm can't supply the whole requirement of CoF, Kishanganj then BASU shall have the liberty to distribute work amongst more than one bidders at L1 rate depending upon the requirement of number of persons required.
- vii. BASU does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid, and reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to cancel the tender document process and reject all the bids, at any time prior to award of the contract without assigning any reason.
- viii. Financial Bid having agency Service Charges of Rs. Zero, Nil, Fraction of Rupees and other anomalies will be construing as to intentionally kill the tender and such bid will be summarily rejected.

8. Liquidated Damages Clause:

- 1. An amount of Rs.1000/- per point per day will be levied as liquidated damage in case the point remains unattended without any prior intimation to the office and alternative arrangement. Whenever and wherever it is found that the work of the contractual staff at a particular point is not up to the mark, it will be brought to the notice of the supervisory staff of the firm by CoF, BASU, and if no action is taken within one hour, liquidated damages clause will be invoked.
- 2. Any misconduct/misbehavior on part of the manpower deployed by the agency will not be tolerated and such person(s) will have to be replaced immediately.
- 3. Frequent change of workers will not be allowed. If this practice is observed, then the point of work will be treated as unattended and an amount of Rs.1000/- per point / per day will be deducted from the bill of contractor.
- 4. The labourers of the contractor are required to be present for the whole period of the office hours or as per requirement.
- 5. Any other miscellaneous work will be carried out by the contract workers as per requirement from time to time.
- 6. The Competent Authority of BASU reserves the right to reject any or all Tenders in whole or in part without assigning any reasons thereof. The decision of Competent Authority of BASU shall be final and binding on the contractor/agency in respect of any clause covered under the Contract.

9. Legal Obligations

- i) All manpower employed by Service provider shall be engaged by him as his own employees in all respects i.e. expressed or implied. The responsibilities whatsoever, incidental or direct, arising out of or for compliance with or enforcement of the provisions of various Labour Laws/Industrial Laws of the country, shall be that of the Service provider. The service provider shall specifically ensure compliance of the following Laws/ Acts and their Enactments/ Amendments:
 - a. The Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970
 - b. The Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Central Rules, 1971
 - c. The Minimum Wages Act, 1948
 - d. The Payment of Wages Act, 1936
 - e. The Manpower's Compensation Act, 1923

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- f. The Employees' Provident Funds and Misc. Provisions Act, 1952
- g. The ESI Act, 1948
- h. The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965
- i. The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1976
- j. Bihar Shop & Establishment Act, 1953
- ii) Service provider shall abide by provisions of other rules and regulations of Government issued from time to time to this effect. Any payment due to the manpower employed by the service provider shall be the sole responsibility of the service provider. If penalized for non-compliance of any of the legal requirements, the service provider shall be responsible for the same and deal with them at its own level and costs, in no way putting any liability on COF, BASU.
- iii) The Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970, and Rules, 1971 there under and the Central/ State Rules as modified from time to time are applicable to this Contract. The service provider shall comply with these and take steps for getting the agreement registered under the Act. He shall also indemnify BASU from and against any claims under the aforesaid Act and the Rules.
- iv) The service provider shall also ensure that no manpower below the age of 18 years is employed by him for the abovementioned jobs.
- v) The service provider will deposit the tax (as required and concerned with contract) with concerned authority as applicable and submit the documentary proof of the same to BASU
- vi) The Service provider shall ensure that the payment of wages as per Pay Band is made to the manpower employed by him after necessary deductions like TDS, EPF, ESI etc. and the requisite documents are provided along with the bills. Further the amount shall be made by cheque/ ECS. Issuance of EPF, ESI cards, etc. is the responsibility of the Service provider. No cash payments shall be made to any of the manpower employed through him.
- vii) BASU shall have the right to check and call documents for the implementation of labour welfare laws and rules.
- vii) All the persons engaed for services by the Service provider shall be considered as employees of the service provider and they shall not make any claim in respect of employment and or other service benefits from COF, BASU in any manner either outside the court or in the court of law. It is further provided that any kind of dispute arising between the Service provider and the manpower shall be entirely the dispute between them only. COF, BASU shall not in any manner be a party to it. Service provider will take all necessary steps for redressal of such disputes and shall be solely responsible for the outcome.

10. Forfeiture of Deposit:

- I- Earnest Money Deposit: a. In case the bidder to whom contract is awarded backs out, the EMD of Rs.1,00,000 (Rupees one Lakh only) of the Agency shall be forfeited.
- II- Security Deposit: a. In case of breach of any terms & conditions attached to this agreement, the Security Deposit of the Service Provider / Agency shall be liable to be forfeited besides annulment of this agreement.

11. Arbitration:

- b) The arbitration proceedings shall be conducted by a Sole Arbitrator to be appointed by the Director of the Institute at the time of the dispute, whose award shall be reasoned and in writing and shall be final and binding on the Parties. The Arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in the English Language and the venue of arbitration shall invariably be at Patna
- c) Provided however, nothing contained in this Clause shall be deemed to prevent a party from approaching the Court of competent jurisdiction at Patna (Bihar) for seeking interim relief prior to or pending arbitration.

12. Governing Law:

This Tender shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the India and the courts of Bihar shall have exclusive jurisdiction, since Agreement has been executed by the Parties in Patna (Bihar).
