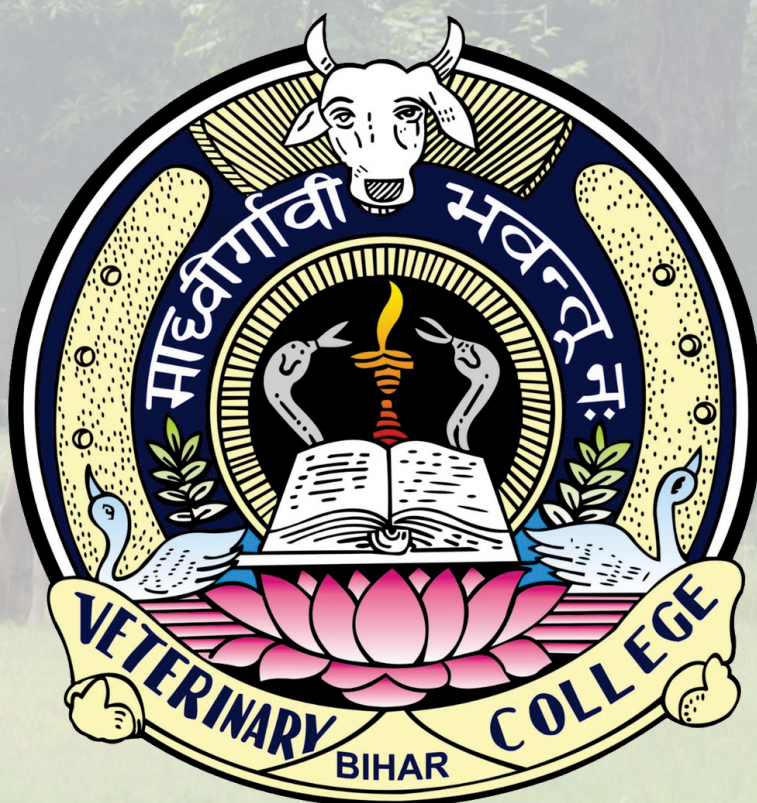

## Illustrious Alumni

### **Dr. Allauddin Ahmad:**

Dr. Allauddin Ahmad was born on January 15, 1936 at Village Rampur Bakhari, district Muzaffarpur. He did his Bachelors from BVC, Patna in 1955 with gold medal. He started his career as Animal Husbandry Supervisor (AHS), in the Department of Animal Husbandry, Government of Bihar but within a year he was transferred to serve as 'Assistant Lecturer' in Anatomy Department, BVC, Patna. Later he was transferred to Department of Pharmacology and Toxicology where he served as Lecturer/ Assistant Professor from 1957-64. During this period (1959-60), he did master in Veterinary Pharmacology from University of Missouri, Colombia, USA. Prof Ahmad left his Alma mater in late 1964 and joined CDRI, Lucknow as a Scientist and Sr. Fellow. Later he served as Prof and Head, Department of Veterinary Pharmacology and Toxicology at JNKV, Jabalpur and HAU, Hisar (1968-77). In 1977, he Joined RAU, Pusa as Director cum Dean PG studies and worked till 1982. Prof Ahmad became the Founder Vice Chancellor of Sher-e-Kashmir University of Agricultural Sciences and Technology (1982-1991). Thereafter, he served as DDG (Edn.) at ICAR (1991-1995) and Vice- Chancellor, Jamia Hamdard, New Delhi (1995-2000).



### **Dr. L. N. Mandal:**

Dr. L. N. Mandal was born on January 30, 1933 at village Dubiahi, Supaul. He obtained his bachelor's degree from Bihar Veterinary College, Patna in 1955. He did post graduate certificate course in Parasitology from School of Tropical Medicine, Calcutta and Madras Veterinary College in 1960 and then MVSc. in Veterinary Parasitology (1965) from Magadh University. In 1971 he became fellow of the FAO Veterinary Faculty of the Royal Veterinary & Agricultural College, Copenhagen, Denmark in Bacteriology and Food Hygiene.

Before joining as Assistant Professor in Department of Parasitology, Bihar Veterinary College, Patna in August 21, 1962 he served in various capacities at LRS, Patna. He became Professor and Head, Deptt. of Food Hygiene and Dairy Science, BVC, Patna from January 17, 1967 and worked till January 8, 1975. During period of 1975 to 1985 he served in various capacities as Deputy Director (Central range), Regional Joint Director (Central range), Research Officer (Rinderpest) and Regional Director (Central range), Department of Animal Husbandry. He assumed the charge of the Director, Institute of Animal Health and Production (IAHP), Patna on July 15, 1985 and served till his retirement on February 28, 1990. Dr. Mandal acted as member secretary of Commission for Backward Class, Government of Bihar to decide the issue of creamy layer. He is recipient of "Vijay Shree Award" conferred by International Friendship Society of India, Mumbai for his excellent contribution in teaching and research in the field of livestock development.

### **Dr. Ali Ahmad Khan:**

Dr Ali Ahmad Khan was born on December 28, 1933 in village Rajpur, district Champaran, Bihar. Dr Khan graduated from Bihar Veterinary College in 1956. After serving in the Department of Animal Husbandry, Government of Bihar as Assistant Veterinary Surgeon for a year, he joined as Demonstrator in the Department of Surgery, Bihar Veterinary College, Patna from September 1, 1957. He did post-graduation in Veterinary Surgery from Madras Veterinary College, Chennai in 1963 and FRVAC from Denmark (1967). He Joined Ranchi Veterinary College as University Professor on July 10, 1978. He took over as Principal, Ranchi Veterinary College from March 06, 1984. Later he became the Director Research, BAU, Ranchi on February 14, 1986 and superannuated from the same position on December 31, 1993. He supervised more than 20 MVSc and PhD student in Veterinary Surgery and Radiology.

He had the privilege for supervising 11 medical student of Patna Medical College & Hospital (PMCH), Patna in Experimental Surgery in animals for MS degree. Dr. Khan was on expert panel of various selection committees of more than 12 Agricultural Universities all over India, Bihar Public Service Commission, J&K Public Service Commission, Jharkhand Public Service Commission and Agricultural Scientists Recruitment Board (ASRB), New Delhi.

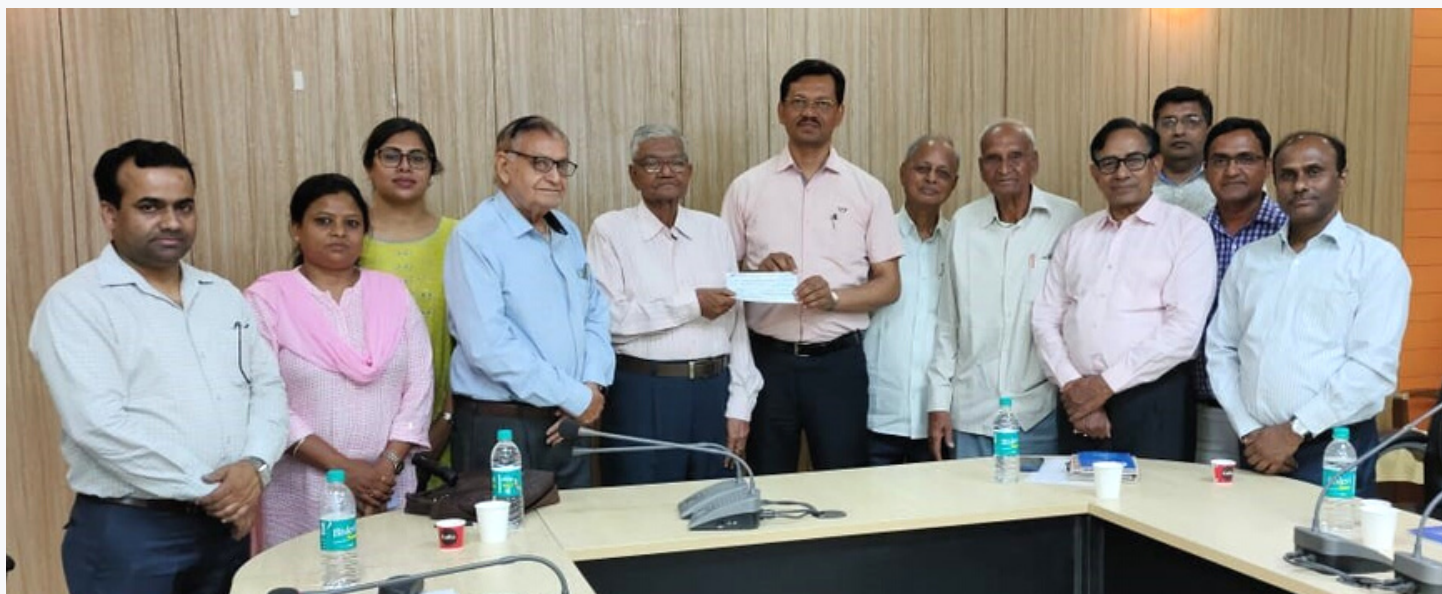
