

## Frequently asked questions for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Convocation to be held on 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2023

**Question 1.** Can I receive degree without having transcript and Provisional Degree Certificate (PDC)?

**Answer:** No, It is mandatory to have transcript and Provisional Degree Certificate (PDC) for obtaining the degree (both In-Person and In – Absentia) in the convocation and information has to be submitted in the **Consent Form** available on the website.

**Question 2.** Is it mandatory to participate in full dress rehearsal of the Convocation?

**Answer:** Yes, It is mandatory to participate in the full dress rehearsal. Those absenting from rehearsal will not be admitted in Convocation ceremony.

**Question 3.** What dress has to be arranged by the degree recipients?

**Answer:** Please see the notification available on the University website about dress to be arranged by the degree recipients.

**Question 4.** From where I can get Angvastram ?

**Answer:** Angvastram can be collected from *12<sup>th</sup> April, 2023 (Afternoon) till 14<sup>th</sup> April, 2023 (Forenoon)* in the **MLT Hall, BVC, Patna** by paying an amount of Rs. 500/- (Five Hundred only) in cash on the spot.

**Question 5.** Whether the degree recipients have to pay for the accommodation arranged by the University?

**Answer:** Yes.

**Question 6.** Can I pay the Convocation fee on the spot ?

**Answer:** No. Fee has to be paid in advance as per the notification and candidate has to provide the information along with other documents by 10<sup>th</sup> April, 2023 through e-mail at [basuconvocation@gmail.com](mailto:basuconvocation@gmail.com) as already notified.

**Question 7.** Can more than two family members and/or friends can accompany in the Convocation Hall?

**Answer:** No, only up to two accompanying persons can accompany in the Convocation Hall.

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
