EXPLANATION AND SIGNIFICANCE OF CREDIT HOURS, GRADE, CREDIT POINT, OVERALL GRADE POINT AVERAGE AND OTHER SYMBOLS USED IN THE TRANSCRIPT UNDER 10 POINT SCALE ADOPTED BY THE UNIVERSITY.

1. Credit Hours	A quantitative measure of course work which means one hour of Class work in theory or two hours of laboratory work in practical per week per credit.
2. Grade	Percentage of marks obtained by the student in a course divided by 10.
3. Credit Point (C.P.)	Grade multiplied by credit hour allotted to the course.
4. Grade Point Average (GPA)	Sum total of credit point earned by the student during a current Programme divided by sum total of credit hours of the courses Studied during current semester/year.
5. Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA)	Sum total of credit point earned by the student during a successive year/ semester divided by sum total of credit hours of the courses studied during the end of that year/semester.
6. Overall Grade Point Average (OGPA)	Sum total of credit point earned by the student during a degree Programme divided by sum total of credit hours of the courses studied during the degree programme.
7. Other Symbols	'F' – (Fail) 'S' – Satisfactory 'US' – Unsatisfactory 'NC' – Non- Credit Course 'I' – incomplete when student applies for make- up 'W' – In case course are withdrawn OAP- On Academic Probation SA- Shortage of Attendance A- Awarded Grade 'A' in respective subject(s) AB- Absent 'A#'- Absent in Online Mode. * Passed by Rounding off ** Passed by Compartment Examination */** Passed by Rounding off in Compartment Examination
8. Percentage of Marks	O.G.P.A. in 10 Point scale multiplied by 10 = Percentage of Marks.

NOTE: -

The student getting less than 50 percent marks separately either in Theory or Practical are considered failed. Student failing in a maximum of two subjects only may be allowed to appear in compartment examination, whereas failed in more than two subjects will be year reverted back to their original class/year.
