RESERVATION: -

University adopts reservation policy as per Government of Bihar.

- i) Reservation shall be applicable to candidates belonging to original resident of Bihar.
- ii) To claim for reservation a candidate have to produce (all relevant original certificate including Caste Certificate, Permanent Domicile Certificate and Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (EBC / BC) issued by the Circle Officer (CO) not less than six months/ one year old as applicable.
- ii) As per Circular No. 11 / आ०नी०-I-11/2015 सा०प्रा० 2342 dated 15.02.2016 in case of unavailability of female candidate (UR-F, SC-F, ST-F, EBC-F & EWS-F) post may be filled with male candidate of same category.
