Theme

Host Institute

Bihar Veterinary College is the 4th oldest Veterinary College of India, established in the Year 1927. Guidelines for abstract submission

- 1. The abstract should include the title (in title case) in the first line; the full names of the author(s) in the second line; the location where the study was carried out in the third line (in title case and italics) if there are more than one Institute where the study was carried then please indicate it using same superscript bearing authors name and respective institution.
- 2. The name of the presenting author needs to be underlined.
- 3. Please include a separate line of e-mail for correspondence.
- 4. The abstract should be typed in 1.5 line space, one-inch margin on all four sides, in Times New Roman with 12 font size.
- 5.The abstract should be limited to 250-300 words (highlighting the salient achievements of the work).
- 6.The acceptance of abstracts will be communicated on time through email.
- 7.Authors of selected abstracts will be encouraged to publish full-length research articles in the Indian Journal of Animal Genetics and Breeding.

Mode of Presentation

The abstracts received under each technical session will be evaluated by expert committee for oral or poster presentations. For each oral presentation, the participants will be given 5 min for presentation followed by 2 min for discussion. For poster presentation, the participants are required to prepare the poster in 4 (horizontal) x 3 (verticle) ft. format.
