The decisions taken are presented below:

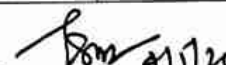

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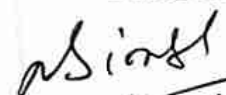

(Dairy Technology) and B.F.Sc. programmes in view of the 6 th Deans Committee recommendation.	- The committee discussed in detail & considered the recommendations of 15th Board of Studies, SGIDT, Patna and 10th Board of Studies, CoF. Kishanganj and optioned that Examination Pattern of 60 Marks (Internal Evaluation) and 40 Marks (External Evaluation) as per recommendation of 6th Deans' committee for U.G. Programme may be opted for B.Tech. (D.T) and B.F.Sc. Programme with effective from the batch 2025. - It was also discussed to include the provision for minimum 35% passing marks in external, Internal theory & Practical Separately in a particular course & overall scoring 50% minimum marks for passing a subject. Hence, the new patterns were discussed in 11th RIC meeting which are annexed as annexure 1	Approved and Recommended as an agenda to the Academic Council for its consideration.

(DT) programme in 2025 batch under DQ Quota and he is unable to write and speak effectively due to his disability. In accordance with the University Grants Commission (UGC) guidelines for conduction of written examination for person with Benchmark Disabilities Mr. Ayush Raj may be granted to appear in all internal and external examination having an alternate question paper in the form of MCQ or True/False questions. The guidelines is annexed as annexure 2.	Approved and Recommended as an agenda to the Academic Council for its consideration.
