The Members Secretary then placed the agenda of the meeting for the deliberation. All the agenda items were placed one by one and elaborate discussions were made.

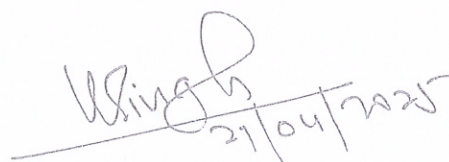

13.2	Increasing the period of Temporary Dropping (TD) from 2 years to 3 years w.e.f. from First October, 2024.	A number of students take temporary dropping from their courses during the programme to join different jobs. Presently as per Existing Provision & Clause 3.8 & 3.17 of RRI of BASU, temporary dropping is allowed for a maximum period of 2 years within that a student must rejoin the programme to complete his remaining course and research works. However, it has been observed that despite being willing to rejoin the course within 2 years, a many of them are not relieved by their employers/ Government Departments due to probation period of 2 years. Hence, it is proposed to increase the period of Temporary Dropping (TD) from 2 years to 3 years w.e.f. from First October, 2024. (Annexure-5). 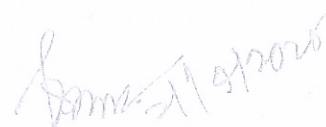
