The required budget will be provided by the Fisheries Department,

		Govt. of Bihar under exposure visit scheme. • Maintenance of the proper database of the fish farmers and various extension activities of fish farmers and prepare the documents of FAQs and their solutions as ready reckoner for the fish farmers by COF Kishanganj. • There should be provision of lecture on various schemes of Animal Husbandry Department, Dairy Department, Fisheries Department in every training program of the University and for this, services of resource person can be utilized from the concerned state department by all the colleges (BVC Patna, SGIDT Patna, COVAS & COF Kishanganj) • There should be proper formalization of records of every online/ e-seminar, uses of WhatsApp Groups and other related platforms for conduction of extension activities by all the colleges (BVC Patna, SGIDT Patna, COVAS & COF Kishanganj) • Progressive Farmers of the state can be used as a resource person by all the colleges of BASU in various training programs and their farms can be used as demonstration unit for the trainees.
	PRTC Patna	• Organization of at least one training program every month for the poultry farmers of the state. • Focus on the specialized training programs in poultry sector like: Bio-security measures at poultry farm, Poultry diseases and their management, Poultry hatchery operations etc.,
	KVK Jamui	• Extension activities related to animal science needs to be increased such as; Animal based demonstration units, Hatchery unit and promotion of backyard poultry farming etc. • Establishment of demonstration unit of Mushroom Hut at KVK-Jamui • Establishment of Implement Shed at KVK-Jamui • Updation of technologies through demonstrations (FLDs/OFTs) at farmers' field.

Agenda No.5	Preparation of Livestock Technology Inventory and Livestock Advisory Services for all KVKs of Bihar	• Proper Planning should be formulated to develop Livestock Technology Inventory and Livestock Advisory Services for all KVKs of Bihar by Directorate of Extension Education. • A committee comprising representative from all colleges may be constituted for preparation of Livestock Technology Inventory and Livestock Advisory Services for all KVKs of Bihar.
Agenda No.6	Collaboration with NABARD and COMFED for Extension Programs	• It was decided in the house that there should be proper collaboration with NABARD, COMFED, PDP, line departments of the state, ICAR institutes, NGOs and Private players for proper planning and implementation of important extension activities in the field by each college and KVK Jamui. • A team of faculty members will be formed at Directorate level for undertaking NABARD related extension activities.
Agenda No.7	Strengthening the Kisan Samvad activities and start of Livestock Magazine by the Directorate	• There should be proper formalization of records and data base of Kisan Samvad activities by all the colleges and KVK and final record should be available with Nodal Officer level. • Process of publishing Livestock Magazine can be initiated at Directorate level and for this purpose required budget will be provided by the University.

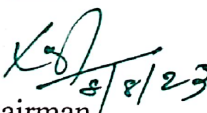
