About the Society

The Indian Society for Study of Animal Reproduction (ISSAR) is a premier professional organization committed to the advancement of animal reproductive sciences through the promotion of excellence in education, research, clinical practice, and extension. The Society was established in November 1972 under the visionary leadership of Dr. C. R. Sane, its Founder President. From an initial membership of 26 professionals, ISSAR has grown into one of the largest scientific societies in the discipline, with a membership more than **4000 life members**. The Society since its inception has been consistently organizing its Annual Convention along with National and International Symposia, providing a distinguished forum for scientific deliberations, dissemination of research, professional interaction, and collaborative initiatives in animal reproduction. ISSAR is dedicated to fostering scientific advancement in animal reproduction by promoting teaching, research, and extension activities; organizing scientific conferences, symposia, and continuing education programmes; and recognizing excellence through awards, endowments, and fellowships.

Weather of Patna

Weather in month of November at Patna will be pleasant, dry and cool. Temperature remains around 22°C to 28°C in day time while overnight lows drop to a crisp upto 15°C. Rainfall is practically negligible. Afternoons remain quite warm providing comfortable conditions for delegates and participants.

Transportation and Accommodations

The main campus of Bihar Veterinary College is adjacent to Jay Prakash Narayan International Airport, Patna (PAT) and about 8 km-10 Km from Patna Junction (PNBE), Raendra Rajendra Nagar Terminals (RJPB), Danapur Junction (DNR) and 05 km from Patliputra Junction (PPTA). Local transport will be arranged for delegates by the host institute from place of arrival to the place of their stay and to the conference venue. Similarly, the local transport for daily movement and the return journey of the delegates will also be arranged. Accommodation will be provided in government guest houses (BASU, ICAR, BAMETI/Dashrath Manjhi Institute etc.) and private hotels located in the vicinity of the conference venue, subject to prior request and availability. Tariff rates of private hotels are Rs. 2,000 per day onwards, depending on the category of accommodation.

Places to Visit

The host city, **Patna**, serves as an ideal gateway to some of India's most celebrated historical, cultural, and spiritual destinations. Among them, ancient ruins of **Nalanda University (UNESCO World Heritage Site)**, **Rajgir**, and **Bodh Gaya**, located approximately **100–120 km** from Patna, are internationally renowned for their immense historical and archaeological significance. **Bodh Gaya**, where Lord Buddha attained enlightenment, are globally revered pilgrimage destinations that embody India's rich cultural and Buddhist heritage.

Sight Seeing

To enrich the conference experience, the Organizing Committee proposes the following sightseeing tours for registered delegates. These tours will be organized on a payment basis, subject to a minimum number of participants.

The abstract should be original and from quality research with a maximum of 350 words (in A4 size, Times New Roman, Font size-12, 1.15-line space). The abstract should include the Introduction, Objectives, Methods, Results & Conclusions (continuously without any sub headings) along with Keywords (5-6 words). The name of the presenting author should be underlined bold and star marked. Email of the presenting author must be written at desired place as mentioned in format.

Mode of Presentation

Lead Papers: 10 minutes for Power point presentation and 3 minutes for discussion.

Oral presentation: Maximum 5 minutes for Power point presentation and 2 minutes for discussion.

Poster presentation: Self-explanatory E-Posters with dimensions of 3 ft. (height) x 4 ft (width) will be allowed for the presentation. Posters should clearly present the objectives, methodology, key findings and conclusions. E-posters are allowed in JPEG or PDF format as above-mentioned dimensions.
